Much better use of space. Participants, event staff always need parking so please have sufficient parking to make it a useful venue

Density so the space is more vibrant between events

Like the idea of making us the space above the Parkade. Entertainment district is good idea.

What I like most is easy. There is always a benefit to having more sports facilities for athletes, wannabe athletes and spectators of all ages. The property is already zoned correctly and used for sports this is just improvement on the quality of the venues and adding additional sports.

At grade transit access provides better accessibility. Wider structure promotes crossing. Consider vegetation to assist with increasing green footprint/emissions mitigation.

As a volunteer track official trying to help Calgary develop future Olympians (we do not have even one in Athletics at the Tokyo Olympics), I am extremely upset that after fifty years we do not have even one fieldhouse and Edmonton has five. I also see you do are taking away our parking for condos.

i don't know why this is not more recreational/sport space. Residential should not be part of the plans. currently the track has stands and is 'walled off/fenced'. i think this should be part of the design so that proper large scale meets can be held here.

i am wondering if some of this should be covered if university students are going to walk to use these facilities

will need parking for all the families that will come to the facility. If this is used for medical/elderly clientele then will need parking for them too.

where is the parking in the north end of the re-design. Mothers with kids can't park here and walk north. Winter is here 6+ months of the year. People will be coming to these facilities from all over the NW and the rest of the city. They won't be coming by transit

For 4 season use, add warming areas/wind barriers and shade structures in the park area

Having a hard time understanding the benefit to the wider community. Is there a public recreation component to this? If not, there should be.

Think more about who uses them. Most of the use for the fieldhouse and surrounding facilities is from school track events, swim meets, children's hockey practices and games. These are parents driving their kids and hauling gear. A walkabel concept doesn't work. This location is too crowded.

How does the other 3/4 of the city and people outside the city access this? It's too focused on pedestrian traffic; but the one c-train station can't support that. Think of how congested the saddledome is and they have 2 nearby stations! People going to hockey practice are not taking the train.

More parking! The federal gov. is transitioning us to electric cars in the next 10 years. Infrastructure needs to support this. Where do staff, media, organisers, deliveries, and food trucks park? Where do parents hauling hockey or football gear park? You can't haul that on the bus or train.

Did the designers even look at what is there? The church on the corner is not incorporated. The current retail and famous restaurants on crowchild appears to just get bulldozed? And pools, ice, soccer and track takes up more space than what they envision if they want to host international events.

I don't like how everything is combined into one big facility/center. People using the arenas and pools won't be walking over to the football stadium; this is just going to cause congestion when two events happen at the same time; especially when you add extra people from the retail and commercial.

With more facilities and mixed use, comes more people. The infrastructure does not reflect this. Crowchild, 16th ave and the nearby c-train stations can't support the huge increase in people. This development would be better supported in a different place with access to two lines of the c-train.

No baseball? No cricket? We need to be inclusive to all sports. If we don't build the facilities than we will not be able to foster the growth of these sports in Calgary.

Would love to see the same effort put into connecting to Foothills by active modes. Also please ensure you put aside a few thousand to put in wayfinding signage throughout, for those who would like to get to Banff Trail, Foothills, U of C, St Andrew's Heights, etc.

Nothing-NOTHING-is being done to McMahon Stadium. Why? This is far older than the Saddledome, and is in desperate need of a rebuild. Washrooms are cold, no hot water, stairs are too steep, I could go on and on. McMahon could be a major venue for concerts, entertainment, etc., but instead is bypassed

There's too many building jammed into the space. It needs more treed and natural feeling greenspace. Please don't build condo units that are too small, too expensive and lacking in green space. Go for townhouse-style development instead

Can you have public bathrooms for anyone walking by/dropping off/out for a bike ride. Public bathrooms are needed in public spaces not just once inside the new buildings.

If there is only one parking facility the corner closer to the University would be less impactful to main through-fares or put another parking facility here as well - it may help with University Parking. Cars will be used by out of town visitors and folks not well served by transit/biking/walking.

The massive amount of increased density should be reduced. The reason being is that the neighbouring areas are already targeted for substantial increases. Can all of this planned density be sustained/used?

Where are all the bike racks located? Will the city be maintaining these walking/bike paths through the winter (An ongoing maintenance budget for snow removal for these paths and adjacent street is required.)

The #2 aerial view gives the impression of a lot of green. How likely is this for a main through-fare? Driving along Crowchild Trail these huge buildings will look like a mass of concrete. Have you provided for a significant budget for the ongoing maintenance of all this periphery greenery.

Continue to have public tennis courts for community. Encourages being active and provides community with a place to gather and play together. The current courts are often busy with users waiting for courts.

Provision for parking is not close. Kids arrive with a lot of equipment - by car - and parents stay. Transit/bike/walking won't be practical and neither will walking from the proposed parking facility. Swimmers with wet hair in the winter (& facility users) also appreciate cars close.

Residential in Element 6 will not be very desirable due to very close proximity to the stadium and activities. The widened land bridge should be enclosed like McLeod at Chinook Mall. Shops could be added at either side of Crowchild.



Appendix: Verbatim Comments 2021 August

Consideration of increased noise levels for surrounding neighborhoods. How much to taxpayers? Scale down the scope of to upgrade facilities. City creates too much density inner city & allows urban sprawl, without the population & economic growth to support it and put the burden on current tax payers.

Focus on the field house and McMahon Stadium. The rest is overkill!

The plans do not show detail plans of the tennis courts. Will the tennis courts remain as is? Will there be an upgrade to the tennis courts? Or will it be replaced with other types of courts (e.g. pickleball courts).

Keep tennis & volleydome. More green space; less impermeable surface. Avoid major tree/shrub loss. Include stormwater plan. Share traffic study. Awkward vehicle access. Need safety 24/7. Pedestrian circulation unclear. Keep focus on sports & not gentrified housing. Consider affordable housing.

You need to have the Calgary Track Council involved to make sure that the major track and field venue works for all major events. Storage seems to be lacking and is much needed for equipment. The city is saying this is the major site to host our provincial and national events at.

We still need a secure fencing around the track and turf fields. We have major amounts of equipment that is out on the track during the year that people seem to like to vandalize all the time. Washrooms for the track and turf fields we need dedicated washrooms for the outdoor facilities.

We still need to have access for cars in the plan as We have to get about 1000 young athletes that come by school bus for a one day track meet to the facility and right now i do not see that. Plus parking for buses and bigger trucks as we do have that for bigger meets as well.

We need to have better access around the outdoor track as for parking and getting equipment in and out as I am there everyday with my truck to do something at the track and from the plan hard to see how that could happen. Parking around the track for when we hold track meets.

We need access to the foothills track right now i see very little access by car. No parking is a big concern around the track. We need to have an 8' high fence to secure the track and fields. Concern about bus access for when hosting school track meets at the track no access for them. Parking.

The main thing that the design concept needs to remember that Foothills track is still going to be the main competition track for provincial, national and international competitions. SO the current foot print of the park cannot be shrunken as it looks in the picture.

Again, strongest possible to U of C Kiniesiolgy and Medical faculties.

Clarify accessibility plans - will everything be wheelchair accessible? Will it be accessible for vision and hearing impaired folk? Will there be a childcare space? Etc

I (and others) am concerned about changes to the existing track at Foothills. The Concept Perspectives show the track - it's not moving - but they do not show the long jump and triple jump pits or the pole vault area that is on the east side of the track today. Also the shot put area is gone.

limit the sprawl of residential development (go higher rather than building so many building)

PARKING WILL BE AN ISSUE for both residents and sport users, let alone during games and meet -

No apartments. Limit hotel and crowding on site. Parking under fields and hidden away. More sports facilities on site. Improve traffic flow. Reduce density and create an amazing sports and event venue instead of a clutter of apartments, hotels

Dont scrimp on the parking! You cant ride your bike to an arena with your hockey bag! You have to have room for tailgating for Stamps games, that is critical! I'd cancel my season tickets if there was no tailgating!

You show lots of new buildings, but you've removed all the parking. It takes 20-30 minutes to et out of the parking lot now, that needs to improve. My wife is handicapped. We have East parking for Stamps games. We won't come if there's no parking or exit time is worse. It's that simple.

Put in a new football stadium and add entertainment assets for before and after games. You go to games and then either have to train back down town or go home. This should be better.

Delete the apartment buildings

I couldn't quite see in the plan, so maybe you already have this: designated bike pathways to connect everything together. I see the bike parking, but by putting in bike racks and bike lanes everywhere, you will decrease the number of parking spots you need and encourage active living. Thank you!

COVER the football stadium (due to timing of our season in winter months) for weather and for protected venue for concerts, etc

Add some play structures/activities for kids and places for street entertainers to perform. Bring music and sport together. A spot where music and art students can showcase their talents. Also see Netherlands solar bike path that creates energy

I'm very excited to have this within our city. It's important to rain a city that promotes physical activity.

There is just too much going on in such a small area. I live in St. Andrews and its hard enough to get across Crowchild tr. or come into the St. Andrews when there is a major event going on. You also need to consider all the traffic issues people will have locally.

The proposed parking (#6) is too far from the actual facilities. I can't imagine people helping their kids lug all their gear and equipment to where they have to play, especially in winter. I've been a competitive swimmer's mom before and it's brutal when parking is far and the kid is cold.

Ensure it had adequate technical specifications to host events, including spectator seating, amenities, etc

Provide seating area for soccer fields so the possibility of matches with spectators is there.

McMahon is used as lower cost parking for University students and employees both on Main Campus and the Foothills Campus. What is going to be done to replace this? It doesn't look like there is enough parking in general. What about the current park in ride for the LRT station?

Start over and let the government that takes over in the Fall look after this. I don't trust the current city council at all.

It's too busy.

There needs to be parking...not everyone wants to take the train and be herded like cattle to and from and the tailgating is a part of the game day experience, it is the best part for many. Please do not get rid of the parking. Many people have waited years for their chance to tailgate for gameday!

The focus to get away from cars is a stupid one. As we get to more of an electric car world people won't reduce how many cars they drive. If your plan isn't to have at least one parking stall per every 2-4 people expected to visit or live at the facility no one who drives will want to go to there.

Removing over 90% of parking around Macmahon will reduce income from Irt parking fees and the stadium will not longer generate income from selling parking passes with season tickets. There will only be a few parking spots to tailgate in and tailgating traditions will come to an end.
