


Inglewood & Ramsay City Projects Update March 14, 2023

Culture + Entertainment District Update: March 2023

With construction underway on more than \$600M in major city-building projects in Calgary's emerging Culture + Entertainment District, including the BMO Centre expansion, the 17 Ave S.E. Extension and Station Rebuild project, the Calgary Stampede's SAM Centre, and more projects to begin this spring, visitors to the area can expect traffic detours and delays through 2023.

As steward of the Rivers District Master Plan, Calgary Municipal Land Corporation (CMLC) is working with the Calgary Stampede, Calgary Sport and Entertainment Corporation, The City of Calgary and the Green Line LRT team to make it as easy as possible for Calgarians to navigate construction.

Beginning March 15: A new traffic and pedestrian detour will be installed at the intersection of 11 Ave and 4 St S.E. to facilitate utilities work on The City of Calgary's Green Line LRT project. The detour will be in place through June 2023. Access to residential buildings and businesses will be maintained through construction.

Travelling from Ramsay: If travelling to or from Ramsay before, during or after a major event at the Scotiabank Saddledome, please be advised that several temporary one-ways


will be in effect on 11 Ave and 12 Ave S.E. Consider taking alternate routes at 25 Ave or 9 Ave S.E. for east- and west-bound traffic.

Please follow detour and wayfinding signs, and check <u>The C+E Access Map</u> (cedistrict.com/access-map) regularly for real-time updates.

We thank Calgarians and visitors for their patience and understanding while we complete this important city-building work.
