We are looking at potentially improving and expanding the pathway on the east side of the Elbow River between the Bow River and the McDonald Bridge, including underneath the 9 Avenue S.E. bridge. Rebuilding this pathway would improve accessibility and connectivity for all Calgarians between the communities of Inglewood and Ramsay, the future LRT station, the River Walk and other connecting pathways, and surrounding amenities.

We would love to hear from you! Until November 15, we want your input on the initial design concept to see what you like and also identify features that could be added to the design. We will then review your feedback, conduct additional technical reviews, and where possible, include minor revisions to the pathway detail design upon future funding.
